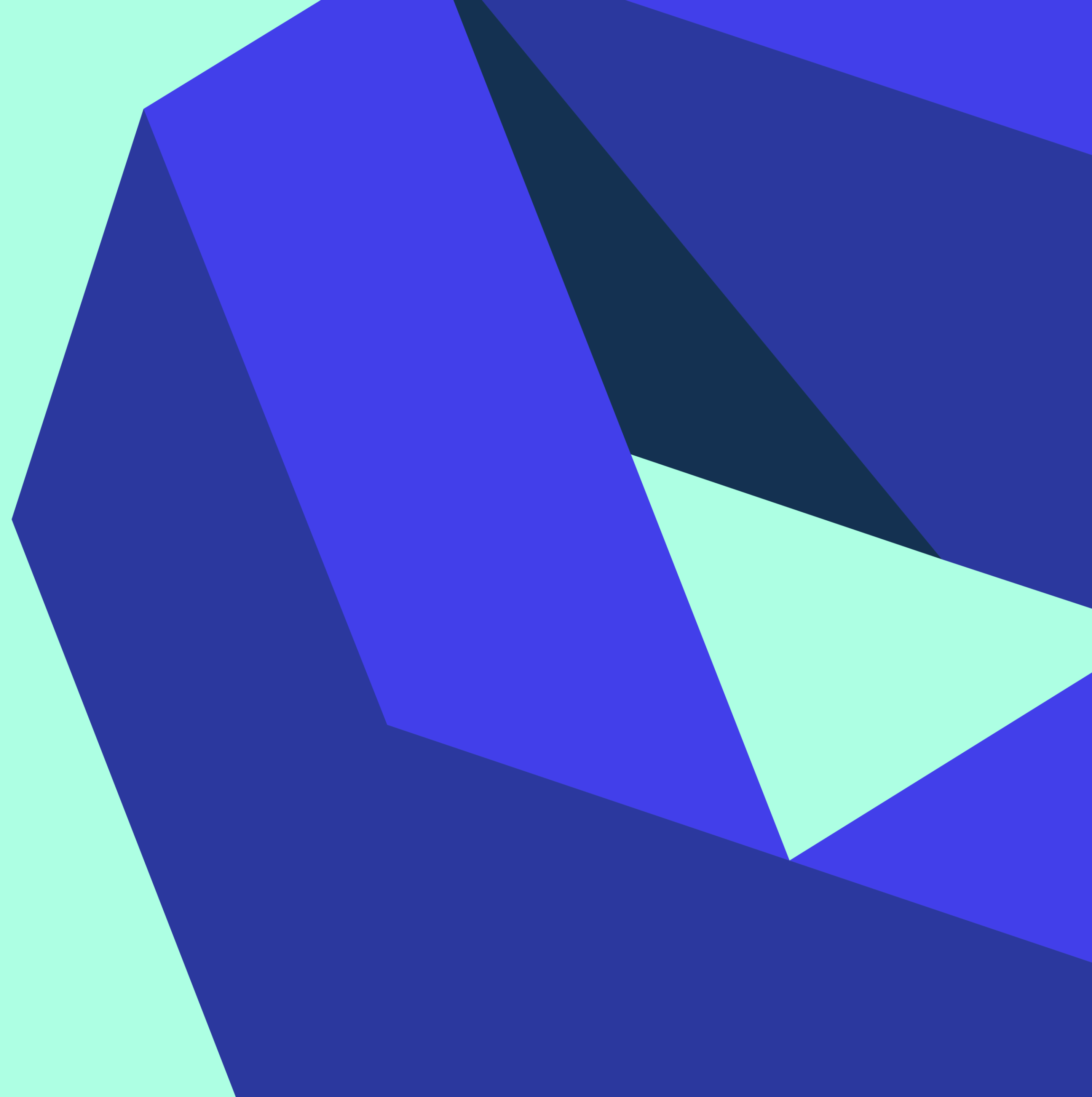
CIF REGIONS

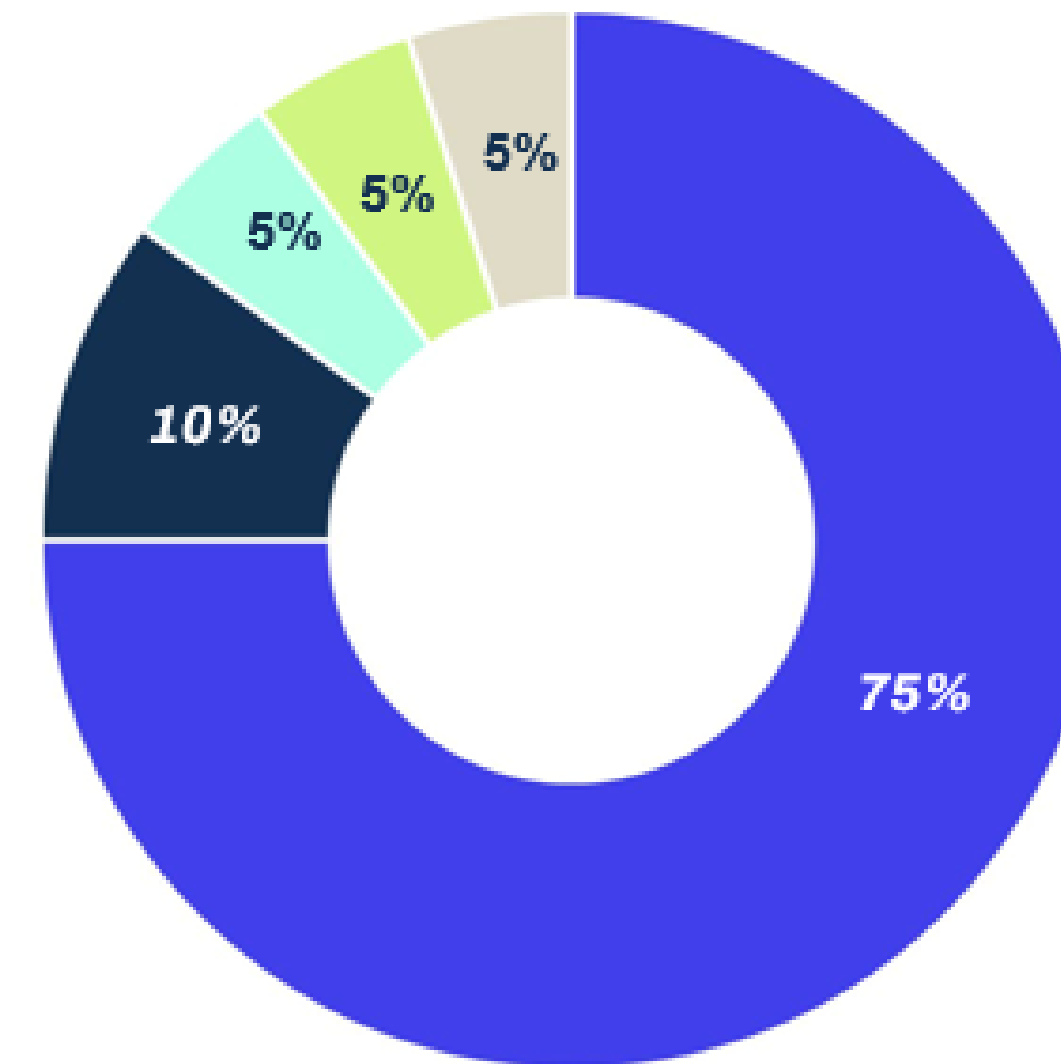

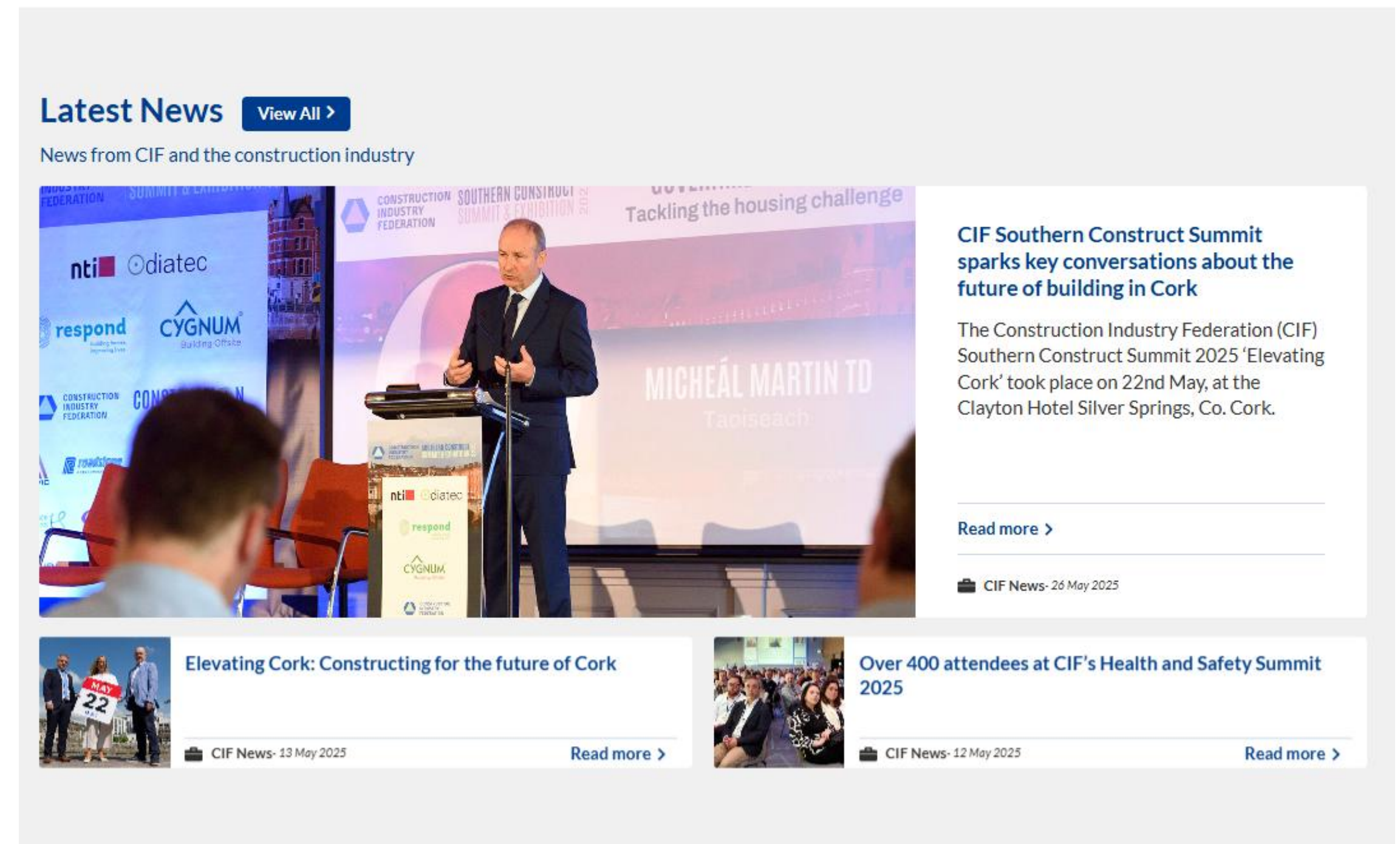

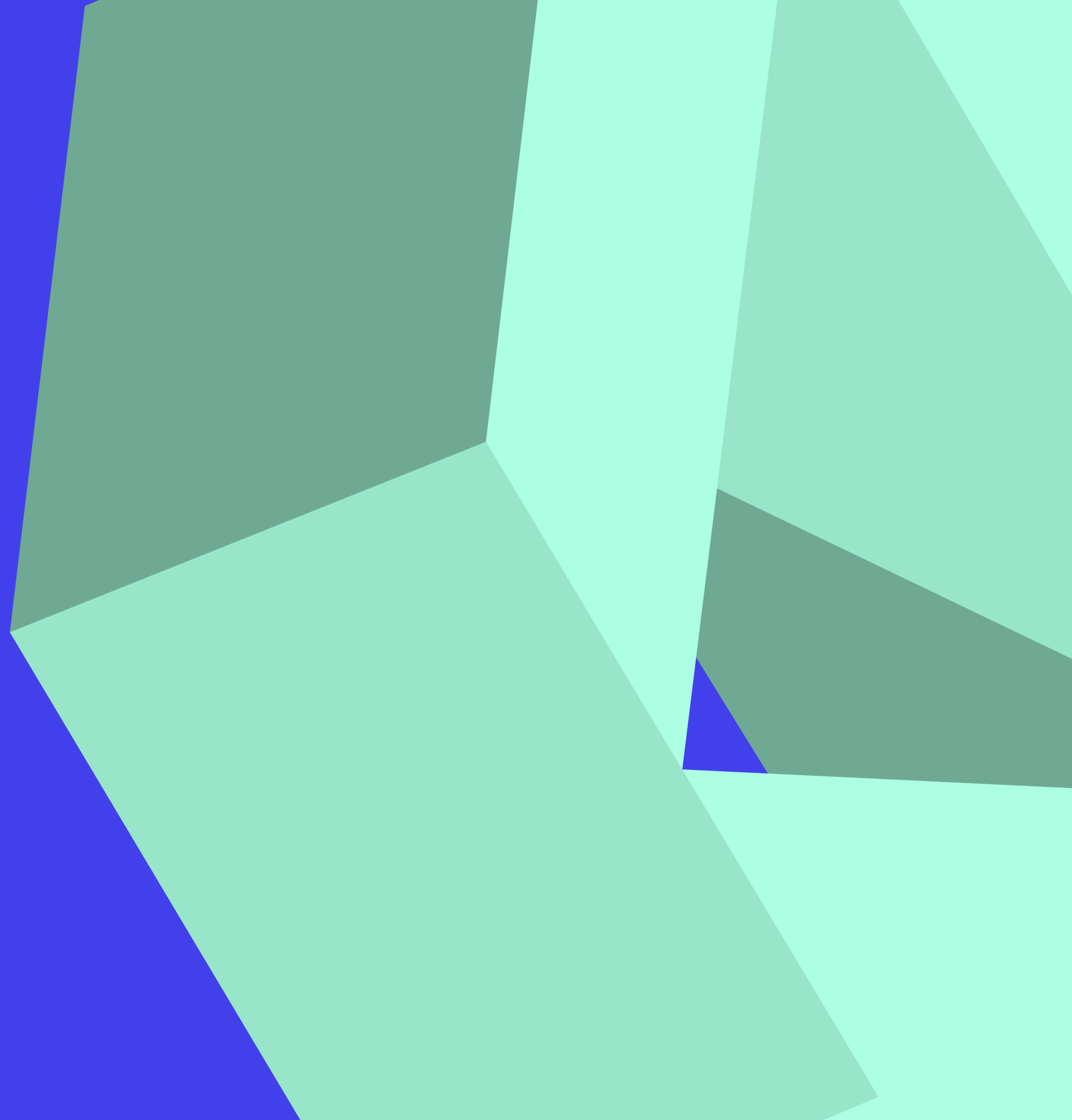
CIF WEBSITE

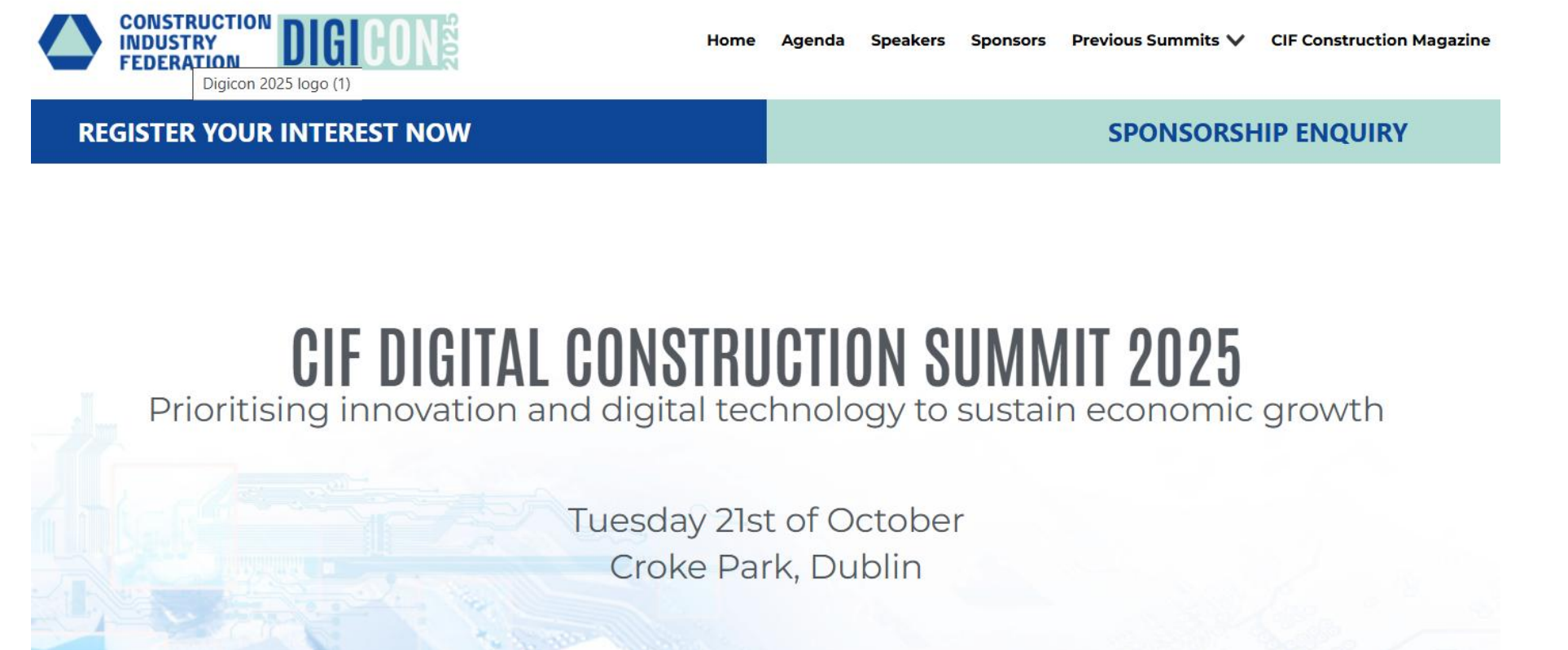
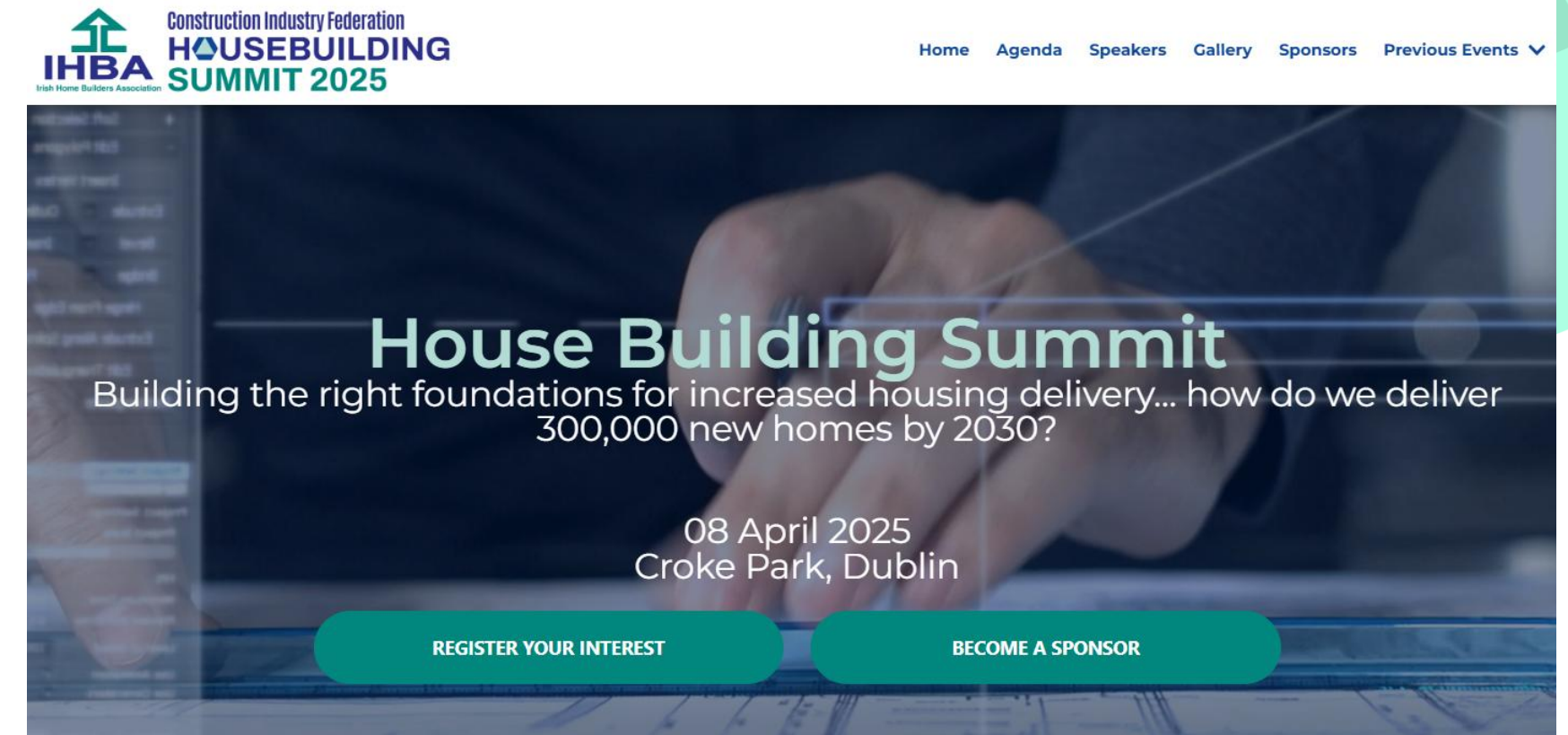


CIF CONFERENCES
