



Contract Lifts

With reference to NSAI I.S. 360: 2019 Code of Practice: Safe use of Cranes

What is a Contract Lift

The Hirer (Employing Organisation) Must specify:

- The works are to be completed to I.S. 360: 2019
- That the Employer (Owner) appoints the Appointed Person
- Provide all information on services in writing.

The Crane Owner must:

- Supply the Appointed Person
- Plan the lift and operate the safe system of Work
- Manage and Control the Lifting Operation

What should a customer expect when hiring a crane on a Contract Lift basis:

- The Cost for crane size, usually on an hourly rate or lump sum price for a given duration.
- The Cost for an appointed person, usually on an hourly rate or a lump sum price for a given duration.
- The cost for a lift supervisor, usually on an hourly rate or lump sum price for a given duration.
- The cost for a Banksman, usually on an hourly rate or a lump sum price for a given duration.
- The cost for contract lift administration to include the preparation of a method statement, lift plan, risk assessment, etc. by an experienced crane appointed person (The cost for this may vary depending on the complexity of the lifting operation or the client requirements).
- The cost for Contract Lift insurance for the value of good while being lifted.
- The cost association with attendance at site meetings and/or online meetings with client or client representatives.

Please note: The complexity of the lifting operation will determine the requirements of the above guidelines.

Mobilisation to & from Location.....€

To Carry out Lifting on a Contract Lift basis the following additional charges shall be applicable:

Hire of Lift Supervisor/Banksman.....€ p/hr min hrs 10 p/day on site.

Hire of additional Banksman (if required)€ p/hr min hrs 10 p/day on site.

Travel time to & from location.....? hours each way at hourly rate.

Cost for Contract lift administration to include preparation of method statement, Lift Plan, risk assessment etc by experienced crane appointed person €

Cost for Contract lift Insurance €0- € value of goods while being lifted €. For additional days of the same contract hire € per day will be applicable.

Cost of Insurance for goods lifted with a value in excess of € there will be an additional charge of € per € value of goods lifted up to a max of €. *(Crane co will require confirmation of value of goods being lifted).*

Overnight Subsistence

€ each per crane operator, Lift Supervisor & per Banksman.

Operators Overtime

Hours worked before 7am, after 7pm, weekends & bank holidays an additional € per operative per hour will apply.
