METHODOLOGY

This survey set out to measure contractor involvement in public works and the challenges faced by construction companies entering procurement processes for public infrastructure projects.

Research was conducted via an online survey with CIF members.


A sample of 221 companies was achieved.



SAMPLE BREAKDOWN BY COMPANY CATEGORY




KEY FINDINGS



PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTS AS A % OF TURNOVER - LAST 12 MONTHS


In the last 12 months, approximately what % (based on turnover) of your order book was from public works contracts?

PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTS AS A % OF TURNOVER - NEXT 12 MONTHS


In the next 12 months, approximately what % (based on turnover) of your order book will be from public works contracts?

PARTICIPATION IN PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTS

The key reasons for not having undertaken any public works contracts in the last two years were bureaucracy and cost concerns.




KEY REASONS

- Too much bureaucracy involved
- Administrative burden
- Margin on PWCs too low
- Lowest price award criteria
- Cost of tendering
- PQQ criteria are onerous
- Delays in the awards of tenders
- Impact of cost increases during validity period
- Too long to complete
- Lack of collaboration
- Cancellation of tenders
- Lack of dispute resolution procedures
- No contra proferentum rule
- Other


PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACT FOCUS

Based on your company's experience, which of the following do public tender evaluations tend to reward more?




ATTITUDES TOWARDS PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACT




CONTRACTOR ASKED TO TAKE ON RISK
