



“Working at Height, Working Together: Help Us Save Lives”

Stakeholders across all industries are encouraged to actively support the upcoming joint HSA, HSENI and CIF All Island falls-from-height campaign running from 16th February to 01st March, aimed at reducing the persistent number of serious incidents and fatalities caused by falls—particularly in the construction sector, but relevant to all workplaces. *Over the last decade (2016–2025) 68 fatalities occurred in construction and 33 in agriculture due to falls from height across the island of Ireland*, reaffirming that this remains one of the leading causes of death and serious injury in both sectors.

The campaign will combine promotional activity with a programme of targeted inspections to ensure compliance with legal requirements for working at height, including safe systems of work, adequate planning, competent workers, and appropriate equipment such as scaffolding, ladders, and fall-prevention systems.

To support this effort, stakeholders are urged to share campaign messages and materials through social media and all available communication channels using the hashtag #FallsArePreventable.
